3 hour Workshop



Let's start with the traditional Log Cabin block and feature a fun image in the center instead of the classic red square. Select a large print and some lights and darks to coordinate with it and you are on your way to building some very sassy blocks with topstitched curves and perky little triangles.

Five log blocks make a great table runner and four blocks are perfect for a table topper or bag. If you want to make a large quilt bring more fabric and continue making blocks.

Fabric Selection

Large Image Print: ¼ yard

Logs: 1/8 yard each of SIX lights

1/8 yard each of SIX darks

Theme ideas: holidays, beach/lake/mountain home décor, juvenile, animals, vegetables/fruits, flowers, etc...

Hint: *it's easier to work with non-directional images, however the directional images are worth the extra effort!*



Supplies

- ☐ Sewing Machine – straight stitching foot
- ☐ Thread: variegated or one color that looks good on all of the fabrics
- ☐ Basic sewing supplies: pins, scissors, etc...
- ☐ Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
- ☐ Iron and mat
- ☐ Fabric glue (I recommend Roxanne's Glue-Baste-it – great long applicator tip)
- ☐ Book (optional): *Wiggles & Waves (2018)* by Karen Eckmeier \$25
