## No-Bake Cake

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6 hour workshop

Be prepared for every occasion with this fun layer cake table runner that you can whip up in an afternoon. Topstitched curves and easy piecing create the cake layers. You choose the frosting, the occasion, number of candles and have fun decorating with machine quilting, beads, yarn, lace, crystals, etc... Simply delicious! 12½" x 48" runner/wallhanging/banner

## **Fabric Selection**

Frosting: 1/8 yard of a stripe\*

1/8 yard coordinaating print (dots, swirls, geometrics,

theme from movie, sports logo

**Background:** ¼ yard medium value to contrast with frosting **Candles:** scraps of yellow for the flames and stripe, dot or solid

for candle sticks

**End borders:** 1/8 yard of theme fabric to match the occasion **Batting**: cotton or cotton blend approximatley 15" x 52"

**Backing**: 1½ yards (or 1 yard if you don't mind one seam on the

back)

Binding: 1/4 yard

**Embellishments** (optional): buttons, hot fix crystals, lace,

ribbons, yarn....

## **Supplies**

Ш	Sewing Machine – $\frac{1}{4}$ " foot, straight stitching foot, walking
	foot and free motion foot (optional)
	Thread to match fabrics
	Basic sewing supplies: pins, scissors, etc
	Rotary cutter, mat and ruler
	Quilter's Square -minumum 12½" (larger is fine too)
	Iron and mat
	Fabric glue or paper-backed fusible
	Book (optional): Wiggles & Waves (2018) by Karen
	Fckmeier \$25



<sup>\*</sup> stripe fabric: minimum 1/8 yard – maximum ½ yard. Depends on how the stripe is printed on the fabric and how the stripes are oriented on the cake, vertical or horizontal. If in doubt buy ½ yard and use the extra for candles and binding.
